Russian River at Kenai River confluence	Silver Salmon	Late July to late September.	Fair to Good
	Red Salmon	First run: mid-June to mid-July. Second run: mid-July to season closure.	Excellent
Kenai River	King Salmon	Early run: mid-May to early July. Late run: early July to season closure late July or early August.	Excellent
	Silver Salmon	Late July to late September.	Fair to Good
	Red Salmon	mid-July to mid-August.	Good to Excellent
Crooked Creek at Kasilof River confluence	King Salmon	Late May to season closure late July.	Good
	Silver Salmon	Late July through September.	Good

Ninilchick River	King Salmon	Late May to late June.	Fair
	Silver Salmon	Early August to mid-September.	Fair to Good
	Red Salmon	June through August	Fair to Good
Deep Creek and Stariski Creek	King Salmon	Early run: early May to late June. Late run: late June to early August.	Fair
	Silver Salmon	Early August to mid-September.	Fair to Good
	Pink Salmon	Late July to Late August	Fair to Good
Anchor River	King Salmon	Late May to mid-June.	Fair to Good
	Silver Salmon	Early August to mid-September.	Good to Excellent
	Pink Salmon	Late July to Late August	Good to Excellent
